#### MASON COUNTY AG SCHOLARSHIP

#### I. PURPOSE

The purpose of the Mason County Ag Scholarship is to enhance interest in and financially support young people majoring in agricultural fields

#### II. <u>FUNDING</u>

This scholarship is funded by the Mason County Farm Bureau and Sunrise FS.

## III. <u>AMOUNT</u>

Three scholarships are to be awarded as a <u>one-time</u> \$1,000 amount. Payment will be made to the Financial Aid Office of the appropriate college or university for the benefit of the recipient.

### IV. ELIGIBILITY

High school seniors, whose parents or guardians are members of Mason County Farm Bureau in good standing, and who:

- 1. Are enrolled in full-time study in one of the following schools: Havana, Midwest Central, Illini Central, A-C Central, or home schooled.
- 2. Are accepted at an accredited 4-year college or university or a 2-year junior college.
- 3. Are not immediate family members of employees or boards of Mason County Farm Bureau or Country Financial (family members of employees of Sunrise FS are eligible).
- 4. Have fully completed the application and essay requirement.
- 5. Students do not need to major in agriculture to receive this award.

## V. APPLICATION, ESSAY PROCEDURES

<u>Applications</u> must be **filled** out and information must be verifiable. Online form is preferred. Information on the application will be judged against other applications. Particular attention will be paid to the academic record, extra-curricular activities, work experience, leadership skills and achievement. Fifty percent of the overall score will be based on the application.

<u>Essays</u> must be original and created by the applicant. They must be typewritten, more than 250 words but less than 500 words, and double-spaced. The theme for 2024 is "What does the future of agriculture look like to you, and what skills will you need to play a part in it?" Content, adherence to the theme, grammar, spelling, and punctuation will be judged. Fifty percent of the overall score is based on the essay.

# VI. PROCEDURES

Applications and essays must be submitted online via the JotForm or presented to the office of the Mason County Farm Bureau, 127 S High, PO Box 318, Havana, IL 62644 by 4:00 pm on March 29<sup>th</sup>, 2024.

A selection committee, named by the Farm Bureau Manager and Service Company Manager, will judge each application and essay.

Announcement of the winner will be made during the month of May.
